Level 11: PURPLE ZIG-ZAG KEYS

Section 1: Rhythm

The new rhythm for Level 11 is the triplet. All the time signatures are the same as you practised in Book 1: 2_4 , 3_4 , 4_4 and 6_4 , as well as 6_8 . Clap as many of these rhythms as you want to each day, because there's no such thing as practising rhythm too much!

When you and your teacher feel you've mastered these rhythms, you can collect a purple zig-zag sticker!!!



First inversion chords have more space between the two upper notes - they are separated by an interval of a 4th, not a 3rd (now might be a good time to revise some of the interval reading we did in Book 1). For first inversion chords, use the fingering 1-2-5, like this:



Play these first inversion chords with your right hand. Remember, read the BOTTOM note and use the fingering 1-2-5 for every chord!



Now let's practise the two different chord positions. All of the chords below are in either root position (like 'traffic lights' - use fingers 1-3-5) or first inversion (with a 4th between the upper notes - use fingers 1-2-5).

Remember, the trick to fast chord reading is to look at the **shape** and the **bottom note** of the chord rather than reading each note individually. Choose a different line each day.



3. Tap the rhythm then play the melody. Check the key carefully.









4. Play these chords. Use right hand for treble clef and left hand for bass clef. Remember to look at the bottom note and the shape of each chord.
