
BEGINNER LEVEL 1

Section 1: Rhythm

It's really important to be able to sight-read rhythms. In Beginner Level 1, these are super easy! They only contain crotchets and semibreves, and the time signature for all of them is 4/4. Count aloud to four before you clap each one, and keep the beat steady. After you've tried these a few times you can give yourself a rating!

Section 2: Random Note Reading

In Beginner Level 1 you'll get really good at sight-reading these three notes:



The notes are written as semibreves, but you can just play them one after another in your own time. Here are the 'rules' for this section:

- Play with your right hand, using fingers 1, 2 and 3.
- Choose a different line each time you try this section. Sometimes play the line backwards!
- SING the name of the note as you play it! (e.g. sing 'C' or 'Doh')

Section 3: Melody Reading

Here are some really simple melodies to play. They are based on the notes C and D only!

The reason there are just two possible notes is so that you can focus on the RHYTHM. The most important thing is to keep the rhythm going, no matter what!

For each melody:

- 1. Clap the rhythm (not too fast); this will help you understand how the melody will sound.
- 2. Look through the notes of the melody, keeping the rhythm in your head.
- 3. When you think you're ready, try playing it... WITHOUT STOPPING!!!
