Basic Cadence Rules

PERFECT CADENCES:

- 1. Bass sings the root
- 2. Leading note to tonic
- 3. Note in common
- 4. Whatever's left

PLAGAL CADENCES:

- 1. Bass sings the root
- 2. Note in common
- 3. Remaining voices step down

INTERRUPTED CADENCES:

- 1. Double the 3rd in chord VI
- 2. Leading note to tonic
- 3. 2 voices go up, 2 voices go down

IMPERFECT CADENCE IV-V

- 1. Bass note steps up
- 2. Three upper parts move down
